

The project « We See the Future of Europe in the Young Generation » was funded with the support of the European Union under the Programme "Europe for Citizens"

Participation: The project brought together 880 people, of which 700 came from the home municipality of Kráľová pri Senci (Slovak Republic), 45 were from Dobre Pole municipality (Czech Republic), 45 from Vísky (Czech Republic), 45 from Kisbajom (Hungary) and 45 were from the municipality of Sinteu (Romania)

Each day was varied, full of lively activities.

On **09/09/2016** the participants of the meeting focused their attention on the festive welcome of partners. At the joint sitting of representatives cooperation so far was discussed, as well as possibilities of new dimensions of cooperation in various fields. The Excursion through the village, connected with reading works of a major local poet created a relaxed friendly atmosphere among the participants of all the partner municipalities, regardless of age or nationality. New friendships were established and old ones strengthened.

The afternoon was devoted to the performances of local children and to the show of a successful sportsman, as well as to singing and choir activities. We devoted increased attention to EU issues, in the form of lectures followed by discussions - 11 years in the EU - what has happened and what has been achieved in that time. They highlighted the importance of European themes, which were one of the main objectives in the implementation of the event. The evening was dedicated to musical entertainment in the form of exciting performances on behalf of the partner municipalities.

On **10/09/2016** the participants focused their attention onto the visit to the local museum of beekeeping, which is the cultural and educational center of Slovak beekeepers. It concentrates materials and documents on the development of beekeeping and its use in various fields of human life. By the given activity we indirectly pointed out the importance of tourism development in different regions of the partner municipalities.

Common love of the partner municipalities in the form of preserving the environment and the beauties of our regions for future generations was reinforced by debates and the expansion of possible cooperation through the transfer of best practices between the municipalities themselves. The program was enriched by gastronomic activities and addressing the importance of active participation of citizens in the affairs of the EU.

The program was full of varied activities, which helped maintain the dynamism of the event. During the afternoon the partner municipalities presented themselves, for the children an art workshop was prepared focusing on European themes. The sports activities induced a friendly atmosphere and in the evening hours music entertainment was performed by individual groups from the partner municipalities.

On **11/09/2016** the participants focused attention on education about the EU, involving all the present in the world of the EU regardless of age or nationality. During the three days of the event besides promotional materials experienced trainers were also available, who gladly introduced the participants knowledge about the EU. It was extremely important to highlight the importance of involving not only children but also young people into the world of the EU, because they are our future generation.

They devoted themselves to the issue of what direction will be taken by the EU in the coming years. By presenting the individual partner municipalities diversity of cultures and traditions was highlighted, which has always been and will be important to pass on from generation to generation. In the context of voluntary activities children and also young people presented themselves, representing each of the partner municipalities.

During the afternoon various voluntary organizations presented themselves, represented by members from the ranks of children and youth. Competitions between the parties natural ferocity and desire to win was induced. Discussions among the youth the importance of their involvement in public affairs was highlighted, to build a more aware society. The voluntary activities involved all groups, regardless of age or nationality, which created a united partnership based on equal opportunities. They also strengthened intercultural dialogue between the participants and eliminated barriers and prejudices against other nations. The varied program produced a great cultural experience for each participant. By signing the common partnership agreement a new dimension of partnerships between four nations was sealed.
